
In addition, the dormitories provide after-hours services to assist dorm residents in emergencies and to solve urgent problems.

## Couple's Apartment



The couple's apartment includes a kitchen, a living room a bedroom and an in-suite bathroom and shower.

The contents included in the couple's apartments are:

## **Shared Apartment**



The shared apartments include two separate bedrooms, a shared kitchen and dining area as well as a shared bathroom.

Registration for the shared apartments will open in August, 2020. Monthly authorization fees – \$ 760 each Full authorization period- \$ 9,120 each



## Accessibility Apartment



Accessible apartments include a kitchen, two bedrooms and a shared shower and toilet.

The contents that included the accessibility apartments are:

- refrigerator
- electric stovetop
- microwave
- electric kettle
- bed base & double mattress
- closet
- · desk & office chair
- · dining table and two chairs
- bedside drawers
- 40-inch LCD TV

Monthly authorization fees - \$ 880 Full authorization period - \$ 10,560

- coffee shop


In addition, the student dormitories are located close to a commercial center that includes a wide range of stores such as a supermarket, a bakery, a delicatessen and other community services.

Across the street from the dorms is a Recreational center that offers a membership at a discount rate to the dorm residents who wish to use the gym and/or swimming pool.

## Social Activity on Campus

#### Social and Cultural Activities:

The dormitories and student associations of Reichman University conduct social and cultural activities for the benefit of the residents of the dormitories.



## **Dormitory Eligibility**

#### Who is eligible?

Students studying at IDC Herzliya in all fields of study and are registered as full-time students.

Allocation of the rooms is carried out based on compliance with the conditions of acceptance.

#### Registration and payment procedures:

In order to register for the dormitories for the school year, it is important to follow the order of the activities:

1. All University students receive an email inviting them to register for the dormitories. This e-mail contains a link to the dormitory site, a username and password that are intended only for the student.



- 2. For reasons of efficiency and the desire to preserve the environment, the registration process is done through the advanced website. Students who wish to live in the dormitories do the registration process online only.
- 3. Log into the dormitory site via the attached link in the email, log in using your username and password, and fill in the requested information.
- 4. At the end of the first stage, after all the necessary documents are submitted (if required), a registration fee of \$75.00 must be paid and the application is then reviewed. (the registration fee is non-refundable at any stage and for any reason).
- 5. After review of the first stage, and if the application is approved, the student is sent an Authorization Contract for the dorm to be signed digitally and is requested to pay the residential deposit.
- 6. To pay the deposit: log into your personal portal with the user-name and password. On the top right, click "My Dorms" then "My Payments", then click on "Deposit" then payments, and input your credit card information. The deposit may be made by bank transfer as well upon prior request.
- 7. It may take up to 30 days to approve and give a reply regarding the residents dorm status. Once the placement is approved the residents will have 7 days to sign the contract and send the deposit before their application is canceled.

- Authorization fee for a single apartment: \$10,560
- Authorization fee for a couple's apartment: \$16,560
- · Authorization fee for a room in a shared apartment: \$9,120
- The Authorization fee is collected twice a year and constitutes a payment of 6 months in advance
- Payment for water and electricity is charged monthly, based on consumption, for the previous month using the credit card on file from the dorm.

#### One-time payments:

#### Authorization fees

The authorization fee in the dormitories, in which the payments are detailed in the table below, is from early - October (close to the beginning of the year) until the last day of September.

The authorization fees listed include: cleaning of common areas, 24/7 security, maintenance and ongoing handling of malfunctions, management fees, municipal taxes, internet and cable services.

Rates do not apply for Study Abroad students.

#### **Utility Bills**

The authorization fees listed above do not include the following payments: electricity, water and air conditioning (refrigeration only). In the shared apartments consumption payments are paid equally (divided 50 % per partner).

You will be sent an e-mail with a billing message that includes all the services for which you will be charged. The debit notice will be sent to you on the first of each month. The debit order will charge the credit card on the 15th of each month.

#### Methods of Payment

#### Scholarships and discounts

Residents entitled to financial assistance on behalf of an outside party from the Dormitory Administration are requested to notify the dormitory administration in advance and in writing that they are entitled to such assistance and to specify the person and means of communication with him.

## Request For Accessible Dorm Unit

In the Reichman University dormitories there are several apartments that are adapted to the special needs of the residents. The dormitory management allows accommodation in these dormitories in accordance with the relevant permits and the actual apartments.

The following is the process of submitting special requests for your convenience:

- ·Standard dormitory registration.
- Attach documents attesting to the restriction for which the student is entitled to an accessible apartment.
- The dormitory management will check the availability of appropriate housing in the dormitories and send its response to the student. The certificate sent is personal, non-transferable and valid for one academic year only.

#### Remarks:

- A. The process of approving the application may take a long time and therefore it is recommended to start it as soon as possible.
- B. The dormitory management will make every effort to comply with the special requests. However, this does not guarantee the allocation of a desirable apartment.
- C. Applications for dormitories must be re-submitted each year.

  A student who is entitled to the caretaker receives a separate room from the lender. In addition, the caretaker does not pay authorization fees.

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# Procedure For Leaving and Revoking an Authorization Agreement Cancellation

Students who have decided, for any reason whatsoever, to waive their place in the dormitories, or whose studies the IDC academic center, has canceled, will be subject to the following cancellation rules:

- 1. A request to cancel a residence agreement must be summited written to the dormitory coordinators.
- 2. Registration fees for \$75 are not refunded.
- 3. The following table shows the fines according to the date of the departure request:
- 4. Cancellation fines are effective from the date of signature of the agreement and not from the date of commencement of the authorization date.

\*The above table refers to students who are in their first year at the dormitories. This table does not apply to students who renewed their contracts.

Note – Covid -19 pandemic or remote classes does not constitute a justifiable reason for cancellation request. Therefore, cancellation fee will apply in accordance with the policies below.

## **Environment**

The dormitory management has a goal to protect the environment. Each and every one of us has the opportunity to help and contribute to the preservation of the environment. Therefore, recycling bins have been installed in the dormitories.

In the dormitories there are two types of recycling cans:

- Orange Bins plastic and beverage cartons.
- Blue Bins paper, newspapers and cardboard.

In addition, the dormitory management has implemented advanced technological solutions that enable saving printed paper.

In the 2018/2019 school year the dormitory administration saved over 37,000 pieces of paper!
